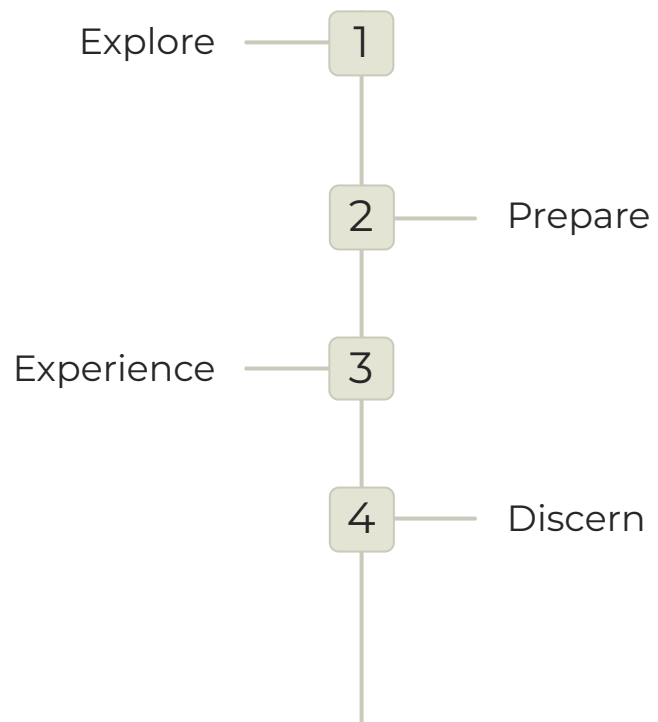

The Invitation Pathway

LeaderPrint is not applied for — it is a journey mindfully entered. The pathway below is not an audition, nor an application process.. It is a series of thresholds of engagement, each one carrying a deeper invitation. A leader moves through at their own pace, with discernment honoured at every stage.





Step One

Explore

Attend an Exploration Session · **Half Day**

A curated half-day experience designed to give an invited leader a genuine first encounter with LeaderPrint — its spirit, its depth, and the quality of its community. This is not a pitch or a preview. It is the beginning of a real conversation between a leader and the possibility of formation.

WHAT HAPPENS

Worship & Prayer

A brief time of worship and prayer to establish the tone — this space is different from a boardroom or a conference.

Shepherd + Equip

A focused teaching built around **The Hidden Fracture**: naming the isolation and fragmentation that senior leaders carry, and the possibility of an integrated, whole life.

Disciple Discussion

A facilitated discussion in small groups — an honest, guided conversation exploring where fracture lives in each leader's life, and what wholeness might actually cost.

The Pathway Ahead

A clear, unhurried description of the pathway ahead — what comes next and what it involves, offered without pressure.

NOTE

The Exploration Session is **invitation-only** and requires a **\$10.00 (US Dollars) reservation fee**.

A leader attends because someone in the community believed they were ready to encounter the LeaderPrint experience. That sponsorship matters — it is already an act of Biblical leadership formation.

Step Two

Prepare

Complete the Foundation Training · **Online** · **Self-Paced**

A required online preparation module is completed before attending an Impact Day as a guest. This is not gatekeeping — it is an act of honour toward the existing community. A guest who arrives prepared participates fully rather than just observing.

The cultural DNA: high trust, vulnerability, peer accountability, formation over performance. What it means to enter a LeaderPrint space.



SENT: Foundation Training is sent to the leader following the Exploration Session, when they express the desire to continue. It is completed before their assigned Impact Day.

Step Three

Experience

Attend an Impact Day as a Guest · **Full Day · Full Participation**

The leader attends a full Impact Day — not as an observer seated at the back, but as a full participant. They sit in small groups, engage with the LeaderPrint Scan alongside the community, and enter the full rhythm of the day. They experience what membership of this journey would actually mean for their life.

WHAT THE LEADER EXPERIENCES

- The complete Impact Day structure: worship and prayer, teaching, and peer coaching in small groups.
- The depth, trust, and spirit of the existing community in its natural rhythm.
- The LeaderPrint Scan in a community context for the first time — discerning together, not alone.
- An honest sense of what covenanting to this journey would cost and what it would give.

WHAT THE COMMUNITY EXPERIENCES

A guest who arrives prepared — with context, respect for the culture, and genuine readiness to engage.

An opportunity to extend the community's spirit of welcome without disrupting its depth.

IMPORTANT

Guests attend as **full participants**, not as observers. The Impact Day is not a showcase — it is a regular gathering of the existing community.

The guest's presence is an act of trust, and the community's welcome is an act of formation.

The seat reservation fee for Exploration is **\$25.00** — to be applied to the engagement fee if membership is chosen.

Step Four

Discern

The Decision Point

Following the Guest Impact Day, the leader is asked to make a decision: to join the journey, or to step back. This decision is required — an open-ended, unresolved engagement serves neither the leader nor the community. But both outcomes are received with honour and without pressure.

JOINING THE JOURNEY MEANS

01

A covenant commitment to the LeaderPrint formation community. *(Includes an engagement commitment of \$75 per month.)*

02

Attending the quarterly rhythm: Impact Day, Integration Session, and Community Day.

03

Completing the Monthly LeaderPrint Scan every month.

04

Engaging fully in peer formation — with vulnerability, accountability, and honesty.

05

A 12-month annual formation covenant, renewed with intentionality.

STEPPING BACK MEANS

Acknowledging that this is not the right season, or not the right community — and being fully honoured for that discernment.

No re-engagement pressure. The door remains open.

A leader who steps back with integrity has demonstrated the very quality of honest self-awareness that LeaderPrint seeks to form.

TIMING

The decision is **not made in the room** at the end of the Impact Day.

A brief discernment window follows — allowing the leader to pray, reflect, and respond from a place of **stillness rather than emotion**.
